

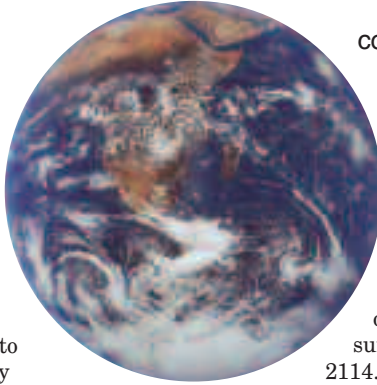
# Innovate to Survive Conference
